The Consumer and Family Advisory Committee (formally known as the Client Advisory Panel) has several staff liaisons and a total of twelve (12) members who represent different areas of GIHN services. Each member serves on the committee for two years. Meetings are held bi-monthly on the third Thursday of the month and last approximately one hour. Each member will receive a stipend of \$30. Attendance is expected and input is encouraged.

Various activities a committee member has the opportunity to become involved in include:

- Helping to make recommendations to improve mental health services.
- Planning and organizing wellness initiatives and educational opportunities for consumers and the community.
- Reviewing and providing feedback on agency operations, policies, performance indicators, and consumer satisfaction survey reports.
- Participation in Self-Advocacy through events such as Walk-a-Mile in my shoes.
